In March, 1982 he was named pastor of St. Lucy Church, Yorkville from which he retired August 31, Over the years Father Bernie served as a Chaplain to the Boy Scouts of Gallia and Lawrence Counties and was Deanery Director of the Nativity Deanery CWC.
